Rider Education

Winterize Your Goldwing



Since most of the Wing riders in New England do not ride year around, your Wing should be winterized before being "put to bed" for the winter.

1) Battery

The battery should be connected to a trickle charger. If the Wing is in an area with power you may leave the battery on the Wing, otherwise remove the battery so it can be charged.

2) Oil

You should change your oil and filter. This will remove accumulated acids, moisture and other crud that would not be good for the engine while it sits idle for the winter. It is also a good idea to remove the plugs and squirt a little oil into each cylinder then replace the spark plugs.

3) Fuel

Always fill the tank and add a product such as Sta-bil. Partially empty tanks allow moisture to accumulate. The moisture can cause rust in the fuel tank and plug the carburetor.

4) Tires

Tires should be cleaned and inflated before storing the Wing. The Wing should be on its center stand if it has one.

5) Cleaning

Dirt and moisture can damage electrical components, fuel systems, and upholstery. Wash and wax your bike before storing it for the winter. If you must leave the wing outside, completely cover the bike. Do not cover your wing if it will be inside since that could allow moisture to accumulate under the cover.

Though if like me, you are to "lazy" to go through all that work, you could just purchase a full set of Gerbings and ride all winter.

Aunt Jemima delivered the eulogy and lovingly described Doughboy as a man who never knew how much he was kneaded. Born and bread in Minnesota, Doughboy rose quickly in show business, but his later life was filled with turnovers.
